How we are improving connectivity in Hillingdon

Hillingdon is part of the West London Alliance's (WLA) Fibre West programme which is using grant funding to connect public buildings in not spots.

It also part of the WLA's Expanding Opportunities programme which is creating the right conditions to accelerate investment in wireless connectivity infrastructure.

Wayleave agreements are also in place which give Operators access to the borough's housing stock.

An open access agreement is in place which gives an Operator access to street lighting assets for the deployment of small cells. As Hillingdon is offering access to street assets on an open access basis, the Council is open to further agreements.

The north of the borough and Heathrow village is the area of concern with the push to have Full Fibre installed.
